

How to Create Your Medicare.gov Account

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Have the following ready:

- Your red, white, and blue Medicare card
- An active email address
- Your date of birth
- Your ZIP code (*and possibly your full address*)
- A computer, tablet, or smartphone with internet access

STEP 1: GO TO MEDICARE.GOV

1:

- Open your internet browser and type: www.Medicare.gov
- Click "Log in" (top right corner) and select "Create account"

STEP 2: ENTER YOUR MEDICARE INFORMATION

2:

- Enter your Medicare Number exactly as shown on your card without hyphens
- Enter your Part A coverage start date (found on your card)

STEP 3: CONFIRM PERSONAL INFORMATION

3:

- Last name
- Residential ZIP code
- Date of birth
- Email address

STEP 4: CREATE LOGIN INFORMATION

4:

- Create a username
- Create a strong password (*use letters, numbers, and symbols*)
- Select and answer security questions
- Medicare will send a verification code to your email to confirm your account

STEP 5: REVIEW AND FINISH

5:

- Double-check your information
- Click 'Create Account' to complete setup

HOW TO LOG IN LATER

- Go to www.Medicare.gov
- Click 'Log in'
- Enter your username and password

WHAT YOU CAN DO WITH YOUR ACCOUNT

- View Medicare claims and summary notices
- Compare prescription drug plans
- Track deductibles and out-of-pocket spending
- Switch to electronic notices
- Print a replacement Medicare card
